We are currently working to complete the cut over for the new DIA Internet services. If you have not sent in an application via mail, email or through our submittable website form, your current DSL plan will be changed to the most comparable new plan from what your plan is currently. The Rural Broadband Service that provided cooperative members DSL will be discontinued in our area at completion of our project. BBTC member DSL services will begin the process of moving to our new Direct Internet Access as soon as testing completes in the coming weeks. The cut to our new Internet service will happen one neighborhood at a time and will complete in the month of June.

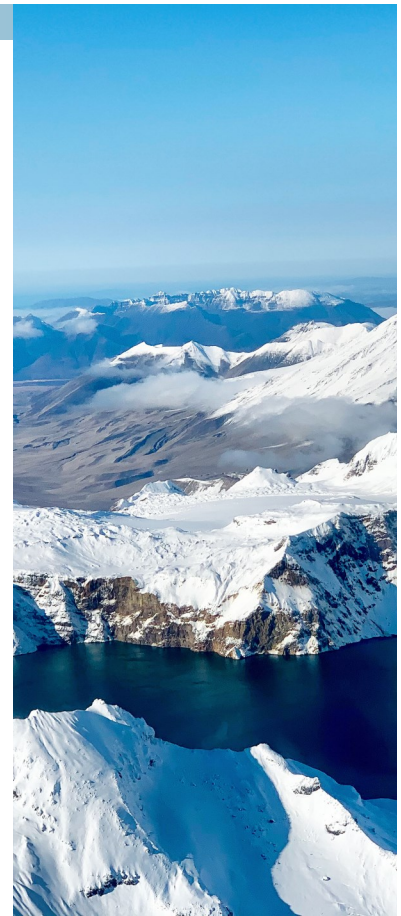
