Bristol Bay Telephone Cooperative (BBTC), a telecommunications cooperative providing local telephone, high speed internet, and cellular service, has an opening for an **Outside Plant Technician** at our King Salmon office. JOB DESCRIPTION:

Installs, maintains, tests, and repairs all outside plant (OSP) cable facilities and related equipment. Installs direct buried cable/fiber and other facilities using plowing, digging, and trenching equipment. Technician also clears trouble tickets, installs subscriber carrier systems, maintains necessary records, provides reports, completes requests for new service, determines methodology for installing telephone service, determines appropriateness of equipment changes or modifications, tests trunks, tests links, and installs communication circuits. Reports to a Project Manager or Outside Plant Technician Supervisor.

Pay Scale from \$23 – \$38 an hour DOE. BBTC provides a generous 401K package and comprehensive dental and health insurance.

Pre-employment drug/alcohol screening is required. Driver's License is required.

JOB FUNCTIONS:

- Install Outside Plant (OSP) facilities according to engineered work orders or service orders in compliance with RUS and NEC Standards.
- Install and maintain copper and fiber optic cable and distribution systems
- Perform copper splicing to company and RUS standards.
- Perform routine maintenance and repair on OSP facilities, buried cable, pedestals etc.
- Install and maintain network interface devices (NID)
- Ability to navigate and interpret standard telecommunication prints and mapping.
- Perform other duties as assigned.

SCHEDULE:

Full time position. Ability to work a flexible schedule and meet the needs of the business, including weekends and late shifts as customer demands warrants.

EDUCATION/EXPERIENCE:

Knowledge and skills usually acquired through technical and electronics training, and a minimum of two years of experience in telephone/cable plant operations or related field. A wide degree of creativity and latitude is expected. CAD experience desired.

JOB KNOWLEDGE / RELATED SKILLS:

Understanding of basic electronics, specification sheets and circuit diagrams. Knowledge of telco plant operations, regulatory/industry standards and procedures, and new switching and plant technologies. Understanding of plant testing techniques and equipment. Use of mechanical and electrical power tools. Ability/willingness to handle heavy physical workload, including climbing, lifting, and stooping; to pay close attention to detail, instructions, and schedules; to respond to customers and community to ensure positive public relations and to retain customer identification with the telco. Must be able to use a computer and be familiar with Microsoft Office and other applications.
